- A temperature greater than 38 degrees should be rechecked within 20 to 30 minutes, if it remains high your child needs medical review

- If your child vomits more than 2 times in 8 hours please contact your medical or nursing team
- If your child has no wet nappies for longer than 8 hours please contact the team Clinical team will add additional instructions for your child
