Mini-Dose Glucagon: Fact Sheet

- Mini-dose glucagon is a small dose of glucagon given for the treatment of mild hypoglycaemia or to prevent blood glucose levels falling too low.
- Mini-dose glucagon must only be used on the advice of a doctor.
- It can be useful in children who are sick and unable or unwilling to eat.
- Mini-dose glucagon is administered using an insulin syringe.
