Purpose of clinical case review:

Starship Child Health is committed to provide safe and high quality healthcare to children and families/whānau. When things don't go according to plan, we want to understand what has happened, learn from the experience and improve the quality and safety of care.

A clinical case review is to ascertain, as far as possible, the factual circumstances of what happened, identify system factors that facilitated the unexpected event and recommend actions to be taken to reduce the risk of similar future patient safety events. Consideration of whether those involved met the expected standards of care is part of the review, not the primary focus.

Background to Review: *(Information from Datix or brief description)*

Terms of reference:

The review team should systematically analyse and report on the factual circumstances surrounding the clinical care and treatment provided.

The review is conducted within a framework of fair and accountable culture; the goal is fact finding, not fault finding.

The completed clinical case review report should provide:

1. A chronological overview of what happened.
2. Evidence of the depth of review (staff and patient/family/whānau interviewed, clinical records reviewed, reference to current best practice).
3. Identify contributing system factors.
4. Make recommendations based on the findings which will improve the safety of patient care.
